Aimin Alton has over 12 years experience in the field of emergency services, working as a prehospital care professional for both public safety and private ambulance agencies. Currently, Aimin serves as a Firefighter for the Ventura County Fire Department. Aimin is licensed by the state of California as a Mobile Intensive Care Paramedic, and he holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of California.

In his off-duty time, Aimin is a strong advocate for firefighters and other EMS professionals, and for the patients they serve, by helping raise awareness and create solutions for narcotics diversion within the emergency responder community. Toward that goal, Aimin founded Alton & Associates and StopNarcoticTampering.org, for which he serves as the Program Director. Similarly, as a member of the California State Firefighters' Association EMS Committee, Aimin formed and leads the CSFA Emergency Responder Substance Abuse Task Force. Aimin has been coordinating these efforts to develop programs that give guidance to the EMS community regarding the problem of controlled substance diversion, as well as programs that help rehabilitate EMS professionals who suffer from addiction and substance abuse.
